On the last night of the project here we are with two students, Yessica and Angel, (a young married couple) who we mentored during the project.

While in Acapulco we exposed around two thousand people to the gospel in various ways. We did personal initiative evangelism in the parks and beaches using the four laws, surveys, and even videos. We held a concert in the main square. We even did evangelism on buses as we went around town.



After the concert there was a call for people to come forward. Here some church members are praying for those who made a decision. We also handed out folders, evangelistic CDs, and four laws and had many fruitful conversations

And people responded!

“Where sin abounds grace abounds all the more.” This was very true in Acapulco. Right now Acapulco is listed as the most dangerous place in Mexico due to the drug cartels fighting for territory. A week before we got there two military personal were found murdered in one of the main squares and shootings have become common place. I believe that because of this reality God opened the hearts of many of the people in Acapulco. As Alfredo said there really was a spiritual hunger that you could sense.
