We're reading the Bible (HER Bible, of course) but when she doesn't understand something we go to NIV and then it's perfectly clear for her :P, that's not the important thing. She's listening man, at least she's listening. Now that one of her best friends, that was always unhappy and crying and depressed because of her multi problems, just found Jesus (that's an amazing story by itself too) she looks to be at least curious. Yesterday I told her I think she's hiding behind her religion and all the religious stuff she does because she's afraid to face

God cuz she thinks God is far, very far from her cuz she got divorced and she has a lot of sins and He would never forgive her, so she's trying hard with the religion. That was a little harsh, I admit it, but she looked at me with wide open eyes and start crying. She turned around and left the kitchen, I couldn't say anything. That made me feel like crying too.
